The Bruny Island Medical practice provides team-based medical care with a strong focus on chronic disease prevention and management. The service is based on a patient-centred evidence-based holistic healthcare model in collaboration with other allied healthcare professionals. The Medical practice is situated in the state-of-the-art Bruny Island Community Health Centre, with consulting hours between 8.30 am and 5.00 pm Thursdays and 8.30 am and 3.30 pm Fridays. The Medical practice operates with two GPs, nursing support and a fully-equipped treatment room.

MedicalDirector is used for patient records and PracSoft for billings and appointments. Bruny Island Medical practice is Remoteness Area classified RA3 and is in a district of workforce shortage (DWS).

Bruny Island offers beautiful beaches and abundant wild life and walking tracks. Accessible via a 15 minute ferry trip across the D'Entrecasteaux Channel on the southeast coast of Tasmania, this 362 sq. km island has a permanent population of approx. 600 with an influx of tourists between October and April (approx. 3000 weekly).
